The U.S. Food and Drug Administration Monday enlisted the city's Bureau of Fire Prevention for a crackdown on the sale of multi-colored balls that resemble candy, but which can explode when bitten.

Known as "cracker balls," the fireworks nationally have caused at least nine cases of oral and dental injury, the federal agency said in a letter.

The U.S. agency said it was seizing the fireworks under the federal Hazardous Substances Labeling Act.

Fire Prevention Bureau Chief Godfrey C. Uhrich said no injuries have been reported in Buffalo, but that the Bureau will check on the possible distribution of the impact-type fireworks here.
